

RÉAMHEOLAS

Forbraíodh clár ealaíne poiblí Landmark trí chomhthiomsú cúramach le cistí Céatadán d'Ealaín chun bailiúchán de choimisiúin a chruthú d'ealaíontóirí atá ag obair i roinnt d'fhoirmeacha ealaíne difriúla. Bhí an mhian chun na hoibreacha a choimisiúnaigh mar bhunsmaoineamh taobh thiar den chláir seo chun a chinntiú go gcomhlánaíonn siad lena chéile sa timpeallacht céanna, chun réimse d'fhreagrachtaí ealaíne poiblí comhaimseartha a chur ar fáil do limistéar amháin agus chun ealaíontóirí a n-oibríonn ag gach leibhéal a mhealladh bíodh siad ar an bhfód le fada nó ag tosú amach.

Bhí fíorthábhacht ag baint le forbairt proifisiúnta d'ealaíontóirí áitiúla agus tiomantas chun daoine áitiúla a bheith bainteach ar feadh an phróisis i bpleanáil an chláir. Aithnítear limistéar Loch an Eanaigh i gCaisleán an Bharraigh mar láthair tábhachtach amháin atá gar do chroí bhaile an chontae mar acmhainn álainn nádúrtha ach le déanaí ní úsáidtear ró mhínic é agus tá sé i bhfolach as radharc faoi láthair. Tá an t-eolas taobh thiar den tionscadal seo bunaithe ar an eolas go raibh feabhsúcháin fhisiciúla eile le tarlú sa limistéar ar nós droichid nua ag cruthú siúlóid chiorclach timpeall an loch agus siúlbealaí nua.

Cuireadh tús le sraith choimisiúin lena n-áirítear coimisiúin shealadacha agus seasta, tionscadal cónaitheachta agus cláir sparánachta.

INTRODUCTION

The Landmark public art programme was developed through careful pooling of Percent for Art funds to create a collection of commissions for a wide range of artists, working in a number of art forms. Key to the thinking behind the programme was a desire to strategically commission works that would complement each other in the same environment, provide a focus for a range of contemporary public art responses to one area, and attract artists working at all levels, from emerging to well established. Professional development for local artists, and a commitment to actively involve local people throughout the process, was also of high importance in the planning of the programme.

One major site was identified, the area of Lough Lannagh in Castlebar, close to the heart of the county town, a naturally beautiful resource, but until recently, fairly hidden and underused. The curation of the project was also led by the knowledge that other physical improvements were to take place in the area, such as new bridges, creating a circular walk around the lake, and new walkways.

A series of commissions including permanent and temporary commissions, a residency project and bursary programmes for emerging artists, were initiated.

Cuireann a gcuid obair gnéithe den taibhléiriú, clár faisnéise, scannán trialach, suiteáil, scríbhneoireacht agus grianghrafadóireacht le chéile. Baineann a cuid taighde le comhoibriú le hinstiúid phoiblí go minic. Tagann a cuid obair de leataoibh chun cinn go tapa ag tógáil a lán cruthanna éagsúla ar an mbealach chun freastail ar riachtanais gach tionscadal agus comhthéacs. Ba bhuaiteoirí iad de Dhuais Ealaíne AIB i 2009.

Tá poist amhairc discrídeacha speisialta, an cineál a mbíonn le feiceáil ar phromanáidí cladaí suite i gceithre shuíomh cruthaithe acu do Landmark. Tá oibreacha ealaíne forbartha ag na healaíontóirí ar bhealach ina dtugann siad dúshlán dúinn féachaint orthu ar bhealach difriúil in áit an gnáthamharc fhorhádaithe den radharc a bhíonn os ár gcomhair. Cuirfear dhá scannán den amharc i láthair, ceann den dá shúil, ach léiríonn siad gníomhaíochtaí laistigh dena radhairc, d’amanna éagsúla i rith an lae agus i rith na séasúr. D’oibrigh siad go dlúth leis an Perceptive Science Laboratory i CNRS Paris agus CLARITY, Centre of Sensory Web technologies, i mBaile Átha Cliath, chun an teicneolaíocht, sampla comhaimseartha dena healaíona agus dena comhoibriúcháin eolaíochta rathúla a fhorbairt. D’oibrigh páistí áitiúla Scoil Naomh Iosaef, Caisleán an Bharraigh agus grúpa óige Chaisleán an Bharraigh leis na healaíontóirí chun na radhairc scannáin sin do shuíomhanna a cheapadh agus beifear á dtaispeáint ar lúb leanúnach sna suiteálacha.

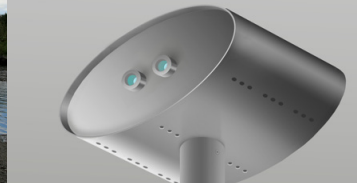

Anne Cleary and Denis Connolly both studied Architecture in Dublin in the 1980's, before moving to Paris in 1990, where they have lived and worked ever since. Their work combines elements of performance, documentary, experimental film, installation, writing and photography. Their research often involves collaboration with public institutions. Their work develops laterally, often evolving rapidly and taking many forms, responding to the particular and individual needs of each project and context. They were the winners of the AIB Art Prize in 2009.

For Landmark they have created special, discreet viewing posts, the type usually seen on seafront promenades, positioned in four locations. Instead of being presented with a magnified view of the scene in front of you, as you would expect, the artists have developed artworks which challenge our stereo vision. Two films of the view will be presented, one for each eye, but depicting different activities within the scenes, times of day, or different seasons. They have worked closely with the Perceptive Science Laboratory at CNRS Paris and CLARITY, Centre of Sensory Web technologies, in Dublin, to develop the technology, a contemporary example of a successful arts and science collaboration. Local children via St. Joseph's school, Castlebar and Castlebar youth group worked closely with the artists to devise and then film scenes for the locations which will be shown on a continuous loop in the installations.

Is ealaíontóir Meán Measctha í Elaine Griffin atá ina cónaí agus ag obair i gCathair na Mart, Contae Mhaigh Eo. Fiosraíonn a cuid saothar caidreamh an choirp le timpeallachtaí ar leithligh agus baintear amach é trí úsáid a bhaint as réimsí éagsúla den mheán lena n-airítear gloine, x-gha, ceirmeach agus oibreacha ealaíne a sholáthraítear go digiteach. Tá meán an choincheapa ina chloch coirnéil ar a cuid cleachtas.

Tá rian dealbhóireachta d’oibreacha ealaíne cré-umha a bhaineann go háirithe leis an suíomh seo forbartha ag Elaine do Landmark agus beidh siad suite timpeall an locha. Píocadh smaoineamh Elaine de bharr ar fíneáltacht agus íogaireacht a cuid oibre don timpeallacht, rud a sheas amach as an líon mór d’iarratais a bheartaíonn oibreacha dealbhóireachta ar mhórsála a úsáid. Mheall coincheap na n-oibreacha atá beagnach i bhfolach nó atá ort iad a chuardach an painéal agus an bealach cliste ina féidir le cuid acu oibriú leis an tírdhreach nádúrtha ar nós bláth a féidir leis meascadh leis na bláthanna nádúrtha i rith an Earraigh agus an tSamhraidh agus a féidir leis seasamh amach leis féin sa gheimhreadh.

Elaine Griffin is a Mixed Media artist living and working in Westport, County Mayo. Her work explores the relationship of the human body to particular environments and is executed in a variety of media, including glass, x-ray, ceramic and digitally rendered artworks. An appropriateness of medium to the concept is a cornerstone of her practice.

For Landmark Elaine has developed a sculpture trail of permanent bronze artworks, specifically related to the area, which will be positioned around the lake. Unlike the huge number of applications proposing single large scale sculptural works, Elaine's idea was selected because of its subtlety and sensitivity to the environment. The concept of the works being almost hidden, or having to actively search them out, appealed to the judging panel and the clever way some may work with the natural landscape, such as a flower which will blend in with the natural flowers throughout spring and summer and be left standing alone and clearly visible during winter.

JENNIFER BRADY – ‘The Known World’

Is leis an íomhá gluaiستهach a oibríonn Jennifer Brady go príomha, agus inúchann a cuid saothar na scéalta sin atá fite fuaite leis agus fréamhaithe i suíomhanna sóisialta agus cultúrtha ar leith. Is cuid lárnach dá cuid oibre é an creideamh i gcarachtar na míréalaíochta atá inghreamaithe sa phróiseas scannaíochta. Snaíonn sí gnéithe den scannánaíochta ficsin agus neamhficsin leis an mbunábhar fírinneach – na himeachtaí agus na háiteanna – chun réaltacht chlaonta do na háiteanna seo a chruthú. Is é a spreagann a cuid oibre ná dúil i léiriúcháin chomhaimseartha den fhírinne i réaltacht atá mínithe dúinn tríd na meáin go minic.

Clár trialach faisnéise faoin dúlra is ea ‘The Known World’, ina míníonn glór dúinn an nasc atá idir an eala agus éiginnteacht agus amhras. Baineann an físeán le leochaileacht an eolais, agus cuireann sé an t-aistriú agus an t-athrú os ár gcomhair i bhfoirm stair dúlra. Saothar nach clár faisnéise é agus nach cumadóireacht é atá ann, ina bhfeictear íomhánna de Loch an Eanaigh agus de na healaí balbha a chónaíonn ann. Léiríonn príomhphearsa an fhíseáin seo saol dúinn, saol nach bhfuil sa réaltacht ann ach raon síorathraitheach smaointe.

Working primarily with the moving image, Jennifer Brady's work investigates the embedded narratives of specific social and cultural sites. Central to her practice is a belief in the character of unreality inherent to the filmmaking process. Though drawing on real events and places, she adopts approaches from fiction and non fiction film, creating video works which constitute negotiated realities of place. Her work is motivated by a concern for contemporary representations of the real in an increasingly mediated reality.

The Known World is an experimental nature documentary with voiceover tracing the relationship of the Swan to notions of uncertainty and doubt. Concerned with the fragility of knowledge, the video presents a natural history of transition and change. Using images of Lough Lannagh and the family of Mute Swans that live on it, the work operates in the space between documentary and fiction. Its protagonist reveals a world where reality is a constantly evolving set of ideas.

Tá suim aici a cuid obair a chur i lámha an lucht féachána go liteartha ar bhealach inár féidir leo a spás féin a chrúthú leis an obair. Is cuma má tá an spás coibhneasta nó féinmhachnach, infheicthe nó dofheicthe, inmheánach nó seachtrach, is suas don lucht féachána é a roghnú. Féachann a cuid obair go háirithe ar tuairim spás fileata trí thuras ar ár dtimpeallacht fisiciúil.

Tagann túsphointe saothar ealaíne Fionnuala as teideal an choimisiúin seo, Landmark. Smaoinigh sí ar mharcáil: luathmharcáil i luathshibhialtacht, luathmharcáil luath-óige, marcanna fisiciúla a mhaireann agus atá déanta sa stair ag ár dtimpeallacht thógtha, na marcanna déanta ag ár ailtireacht, na marcanna déanta inár gcuimhne agus inár bpróisis mharcála mothúchánacha. Áirítear suiteáil gléasanna déantús fuaimne a féidir le daoine a chur i bhfeidhm agus iad ag dul trasna an droichead nua ag Loch Lannagh i Nascadh Fuaime. Ceadáíonn na gléasanna seo mothúchán tumthach agus gearshaolach óna rannpháirtithe ar an suíomh. Féachann an obair seo ar mharcáil léiritheach a féidir linn fágáil ar an tírdhreach, bíodh sé seasta nó sealadach, agus cén chaoi inar féidir leo seo ár léargas a athrú.

Fionnuala is interested in the experiential elements of time and space. Using materials which encourage immersive, playful and open-ended engagement. She is interested in placing the work literally in the hands of viewers so that they may create their own space. Whether that space is relational or self-reflexive, visible or invisible, internal or external, is up to the viewer. Her work specifically investigates the notion of a poetic space through the exploration of our physical environment.

Fionnuala's starting point for this artwork was taken from the title of the commission, Landmark. She considered mark making: early mark making in early civilization, early mark making in childhood, the lasting physical marks made in history by our built environment, the marks made by our architecture, the marks made in our memories and our artistic and expressive mark-making processes.

Bridging Sounds consists of an installation of sound making devices that may be activated by passers-by as they cross the new bridge at Lough Lannagh. These devices allow an ephemeral and immersive expression by participants at the site. The work explores the expressive marks we may leave on the landscape, both permanent and temporary, and how these may alter our perception of place.

Is compántas téatair a bhfuil a lán gradaim buaite aici, é an Performance Corporation a bhfuil sé mar misean acu “eachtraí taibhléirithe misniúla a chruthú i suíomhanna iontacha”. Tá an compántas ag ceiliúradh deich mbliana i 2012 agus tá obair shuíomhoiriúnaithe úrnua cruthaithe acu in Éireann, Meiriceá, Sasana, an Fhionlainn agus an Chéinia. Áirítear Slattery’s Sago Saga ag Féile Téatair Bhaile Átha Cliath 2011 agus Swampoodle – drama cruthaithe don Uline Arena i Washington DC agus cuid de chlár Imagine Ireland 2011 de chuid Cultúr Éireann mar chuid d’obair an chompántais le déanaí.

Tá dlúththaithí amharclainne cruthaithe ag an Performance Company a bhíonn ar siúl ar an Loch é féin. Mar chuid de Across the Lough, tógtar lucht féachana de thriúr trasna an locha i mbád rámháiochta adhmaid leis an mbádóir agus an taibheoir. Meascann an taibheoir leis an lucht féachana i rith an taibhléirithe ag insint scéalta, ag canadh amhráin agus ag nochtadh dúshláin agus deiseanna an tsaoil – ón óige go dtí an tseanaois agus ar ár dturas deiridh go dtí “slí na fírinne”.

Is saothar atá scríofa ag Tom Swift, drámadóir a bhfuil a lán gradaim buaite aige, agus atá stiúrtha ag Louise Lowe, stiúrthóir clúiteach mór le rá, é. Beidh a lán taibhléirithe ar siúl gach lá. Beidh níos mó den lucht féachana in ann meascadh le taibhléiríú trí thaifeadadh fuaimne a íoslódáil ón suíomh agus trí éisteacht leis sa bhaile nó trí féachaint ar Across the Lough ón gcladach. The Performance Corporation is an award-winning theatre company with a mission to “create daring performance adventures in surprising places”. Celebrating its tenth year in 2012, the company has created groundbreaking site-specific work in Ireland, America, the UK, Finland and Kenya. The company’s recent work includes Slattery’s Sago Saga at the Dublin Theatre Festival 2011 and Swampoodle - a play created for Washington DC’s Uline Arena, and part of Culture Ireland’s 2011 Imagine Ireland programme.

The Performance Corporation have created an intimate theatrical experience that takes place out on the Lough itself. In Across the Lough, an audience of just three people are ferried across the lake in a wooden rowing boat by a boatman/performer. During the performance he engages with the audience, offering stories, songs and revelations about the challenges and opportunities of life - from youth, to old age, to our final encounter with “the other side”. The work is written by award-winning playwright Tom Swift and directed by critically acclaimed director Louise Lowe.

There will be several performances each day. A wider audience will be able to engage with the performance by downloading a specially created ‘audio companion’ to Across the Lough and listening to it at home or on the shore. Mp3 players will be available during the Landmark weekend for people to loan to listen to the ‘audio companion’.

Matt and Rob's artworks begin with the people it is for. Wherever possible they seek to work with the participants to generate an artwork, but try to avoid a tokenistic approach, and instead look for ways in which their actions or involvement can become the piece. They enjoy collecting the smallest actions and elevating them to a dramatic and fantastic scale.

Working with projection, light and sound, they seek to create works that directly stem from the buildings, spaces and places they engage with.

They seek through their work to animate, and create time based works that can be experienced as events and as transformations. By using light, sound and projection the actions of collaborators can be fused together to bring a space to life, and to allow audiences to view it in a new light.

'Lough Lannagh Ripples' is an interactive performance involving light by the side of the lake. The artists will be working with students from St Gerald's school, Davitt college and members of the Mayo Concert Orchestra in Castlebar, to choreograph this special once off performance. It will be filmed and will also feature in the programme as an outdoor projection.

Seinneadh agus craoladh ceol an chumadóir Ian Wilson in ionaid mór le rá i sé ilchríoch. Bhí sé ina stiúrthóir ar Fhéile Cheoil Shligigh ó 2006-2009, ina chomhchumadóir le California’s Camerata Pacifica ensemble agus is é an Comhchumadóir le Ceolfhoireann Ulaidh faoi láthair.

Mar chuid dá chónaitheacht le Landmark chas sé ar agus d’oibrigh sé le líon mhór daoine as an bpobal áitiúil ó thosaigh na coimisiúin. Is í feidhm an chónaitheacht seo ná chun cuntas a dhéanamh ar an chaoi ina bhfuil daoine ag déileáil leis an lagtrá, go háirithe an chaoi ina bhfuil daoine dearfach agus réamhghníomhach agus chun píosa ceoil ar scála mór a chruthú a léiríonn an tuairim seo agus a thugann pictiúr soiléir dúinn ar Mhaigh Eo mar atá sé anois.

Léiríodh ‘Still Life in Green and Red’ i Scrín Chnoc Mhuire, Scoil Cnocán Mhichíl Naofa i gClár Chlainne Mhuiris agus i Mainistear Bhaile an Tobair. Beidh taibhléiriú amháin eile i rith Landmark. 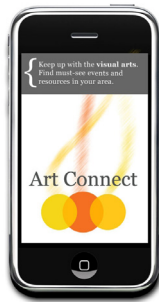

FAKE PANEL

The first events in this series were Fake Public Art Judging Panels. A number of applications were produced mirroring the style, content and quality of usual applications received for public art commissions. Artists were then invited to spend the day as the judging panel, assessing the applications and following the format and selection criteria of a real judging panel, in order to improve skills in application preparation.

Due to huge demand this initiative is planned to be rolled out nationally in 2012/13

I-PHONE AND ANDROID APP – ‘ARTCONNECT’

During the planning of the Connect programme we wanted to find a way to direct artists to the wealth of information that is already available regarding opportunities, contacts, listings etc, and to address this in a creative and interactive way.

The idea came to develop a phone application that would work as a signposting system.
